**Texas Tax Free Weekend 2018 is scheduled for August 2018. Texas Tax Free Dates below.**

Texas Sales Tax Holiday 2018 details released by Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts. As in 2016, the law exempts most clothing, footwear, school supplies and backpacks priced under \$100 from sales and use taxes, which could save shoppers about 8%. **Texas Tax Free Weekend 2018 starts August 10th, 2018 and ends August 12th, 2018.**
